The MAMMA JAMMA BAND is a southern Connecticut based blues band that has been entertaining audiences in local venues since 1996. Their high intensity performances are always aimed at keeping the crowd entertained by offering a variety of live music from energy-packed jump blues to down-and-dirty slow blues. A typical evening also has the band playing some old-time rock & roll, Memphis soul, Motown, and some funk, all aimed at keeping the night moving and the people grooving!

The band has averaged a semi-monthly playing schedule, appearing in clubs and festivals throughout the region, as well as numerous private engagements. With the release of their latest CD, "Don't Quit Your Day Job", the band has finally showcased some of their original material, which has been well received over the years. Renditions of their diverse repertoire are also available on the previously recorded, "Nitro Burnin' Boogie".

Recently, their reputation as one of the premier blues bands in the area was bolstered when the internationally acclaimed blues recording artist **Tommy Castro** along with his bassman, Randy McDonald, took the time to jam with the band at the Black Rock Castle while on tour with the 2001 B.B. King Blues Festival.
